## BSc (Hons) Medico-Legal Death Investigation\*

This degree provides an opportunity to examine the processes necessary to undertake the medico-legal investigation of sudden and unexplained death in a contemporary framework.

## Course aims

This course aims to develop knowledge and understanding of the legal and investigative framework of sudden and unexpected deaths, whilst meeting the needs of the bereaved and society.

## Course structure

The structure is built around the key areas of study required to understand the processes associated with sudden and unexpected death: medical, legal, investigative and psychological/social. The course includes a dissertation in the final year on a subject of your choice.

## **Careers**

You will develop the skills required for entry into a range of professions contributing to medico-legal death investigation, for example, the coroner service, law enforcement, the forensic arena and those working with the bereaved.

## **Entry requirements**

A typical offer will be 200 tariff points from two or three 6-unit awards or equivalent. You must have five GCSEs including English and mathematics at grade C or equivalent. Access courses are recommended for mature students. Depending upon experience it may be possible for law enforcement professionals to join the degree programme at Year 2.
