- Referring heart for specialist cardiac examination when a pathologist cannot ascertain cause of death or suspect cardiac cause
- Heart is sent to our department by courier and is returned rapidly depending on family wishes
- Each case will be examined and a report will be sent out to the Coroner (and the Pathologist) within 2 weeks of receiving specimen.
